Monday-Friday Daily Breakfast Menu:

Cereal, Toast, Fruit and 2 Options of Milk offered Daily for Breakfast

Breakfast times: 7:00am - 7:45am

For a reimbursable USDA Breakfast: Students must choose at least 3 items offered & 1 of those items must be a fruit and/ or a vegetable

If a student tray does not contain a USDA reimbursable meal, adult breakfast pricing will be charged.
If a student comes back for a second meal, adult breakfast pricing will be charged.

Menu Subject to Change

A food component is 1 of 5 required food groups in reimbursable meals. These are meats/meat alternates, grains, fruits, vegetables and fluid milk. A food item is a specific food offered within the 5 food components. For example, chicken nuggets (whole grain breaded) is one food item that contains a meat and a grain component.
